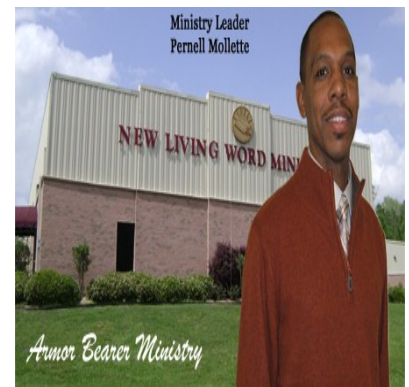


## MEN'S ARMOR BEARER MINISTRY

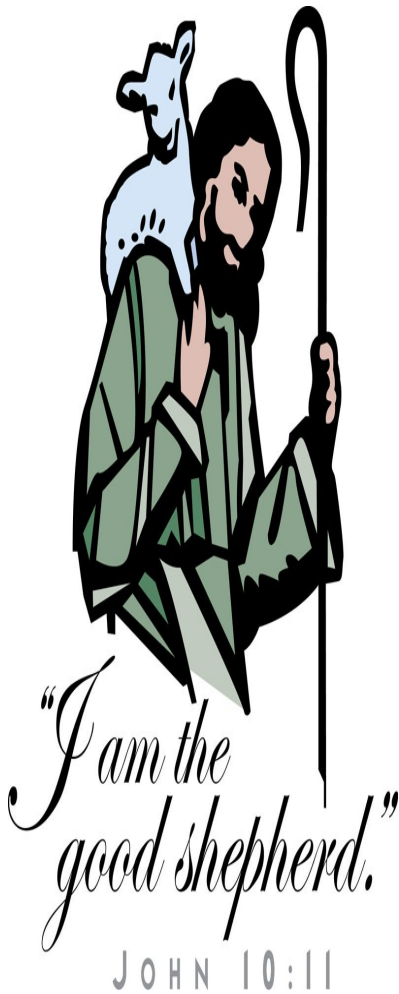

## USHER MINISTRY

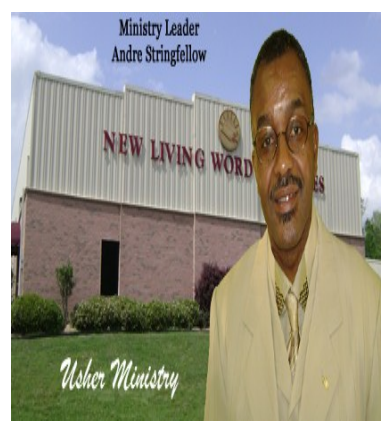

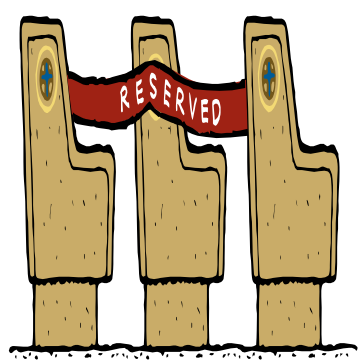


## SINGLES MINISTRY GAME NIGHT
