FROM THE PASTOR

“That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.” Romans 10:9

There are many who are saved but don't understand lordship. Many trust him as saviour but not as Lord. To be victorious in your kingdom walk, you must understand lordship. Lord is a person who has authority, control, or power over others. Lord is owner. Lordship is the authority or power of a lord. As

the authority or power of a lord. As believers, we must understand the authority and power of our Lord.

To get saved, we confessed with our mouth the Lord Jesus, and we believed in our heart that God raised Him from the dead. After being saved, we must learn what it means for him to be Lord of our life. However, many who are saved don't understand his lordship. To help you understand his lordship, I suggest the following:

1. Recognize God as owner. “The earth is the Lord, and the fullness thereof.”
2. Allow him to God. “He brings to us all that he is but we must allow him to be who he is to us.
3. Trust in the Lord. “We must trust him with all our hearts and lean not to our own understanding.”
4. Depend on him. “The Lord is our shepherd, we shall not want.” We must depend on him for our every need.
5. Refuse to worry. “Don't worry about anything, but pray about everything.” Because he is Lord, we cast all our cares on him.
6. Know that the Lord is our helper. “He will never leave us or forsake us.”
7. Love him with all your heart, soul and mind.
8. Praise him continually. When you understand lordship, you recognize that provision comes with the relationship. When he owns you, He does it all for you. The rent, mortgage, car notes, and other bills are his responsibilities. When he is not your Lord, you have to do it all yourself. Life is tough when you don't understand lordship. I encourage you to learn and understand lordship.


