"But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you." Matt. 6: 33.

The key to unlock everything in the kingdom of God here on earth is understanding kingdom righteousness. If we do not understand kingdom righteousness, there is no way for our faith to work. PRISON MINISTRY

This has been an exciting year for the Prison Ministry. Ministry leader, Michael Mims, the NLWM praise team and others from NLWM have been allowed to preach the gospel, mime dance and sing praises to God to those who are incarcerated. We are currently visiting three prisons on a regular basis. Additionally, we have teamed up with Inner-Faith Prison Ministry and gone into 6 additional prisons. We have also recently been approved to begin visiting Swanson Center for Youth in Monroe, Louisiana.

There have been many highlights over the past year but I would like to share the highlights of NLW being allowed to go into the largest women's prison in Louisiana

located in St. Gabriel, Louisiana and being honored at the Jackson Parish Correctional Center in Jonesboro, LA.

During the ministry opportunity at St. Gabriel, there were about 400 women in attendance, the NLWM praise team blessed the Women by singing praises and Ministry leader, Michael Mims blessed them with the Word of God in a message entitled, "Seize the Kingdom".

The NLWM Prison Ministry team attended the Annual Volunteer Appreciation Banquet at the Jackson Parish Correctional Center on September 21, 2010. Following the dinner, the Prison Ministry team were presented Certificates of Appreciation; Ministry leader,

Michael Mims gave a brief testimony and Pastor Baldwin delivered the benediction. Pastor also shared that NLWM is not only singing praises and preaching the gospel while the men are incarcerated but also provides hope once released. He shared that NLW is expanding restoration homes to assist those coming with not only the Word but a hand up with support and housing as they rebuild their lives post incarceration.

The Prison Ministry team members are only farmers in the kingdom (1 Corinthians 3:6 KJV). If you want to go visit Jesus then come and join us (Matthew 25:36, 40 KJV). Please contact Michael Mims, if interested in serving.

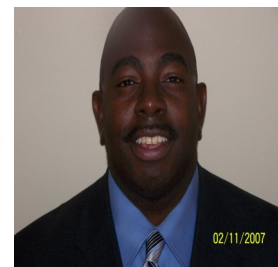
EASTSIDE OUTREACH MINISTRY
